What is ?

Backed by New Life Baptist Church (Northallerton), **New Day New Life – Ghana** is a charitable project committed to the physical and spiritual welfare of orphaned, needy and destitute children under the care of Rescue Aid Mission in James Town, Ghana.

What are our goals?

- + To attract sponsorship to fund ongoing care and support for the children through to employment, the start of higher education or independence
- + To give the children an opportunity to achieve their potential

How do we do this?

- + For Primary & Junior School aged children, by providing nutritious food, clothing, education and medical care for all the children in the project. For Secondary School aged children, by providing for their more specific educational needs.
- + By encouraging the church leadership and teaching staff to provide sound Christian teaching to the children
- + By ensuring that no child within the project is left without, regardless of sponsorship
- + By ensuring that all sponsorships are treated with integrity, confidentiality and financial accountability
- + By developing a healthy relationship between child and sponsor, and encouraging regular correspondence
- + By ensuring that administration costs of the project are kept below 10% of the monthly sponsorship
